2. Description

On the basis of Association Council decisions or Framework Agreements, candidate countries may participate in certain European Union Programmes and Agencies.

Pre-accession financial assistance can be used to help a candidate country to meet part of the costs of participation in those programmes and agencies, on the basis of an increasing contribution from the Candidate Country.

The Framework Agreement between Turkey and the European Community on the General Principles for the Participation of Turkey in Community Programmes was signed on 26 February 2002, and entered into force on 5 September 2002. Thus, Turkey's participation in a number of programmes has materialized through separate Memoranda of Understandings.

In 2007-2013 term, Turkey participated in 9 Union Programmes, namely; Lifelong Learning Programme, Youth in Action Programme, 7th Framework Programme for Research and Technological Development, Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme (The Entrepreneurship and Innovation Programme (EIP), The Information Communication Technologies Policy Support Programme (ICT-PSP), Culture Programme, Progress Programme, Customs 2013 Programme, Fiscalis 2013 Programme and European Capitals of Culture. Beside the programmes, Turkey is a member of European Environment Agency and has ratified a MoU for membership of Turkey to European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction.

A new generation of programmes is being set up for the 2014-2020 period and previous MoUs are being replaced by a new generation of International Agreements.

Normally, the EU's grant assistance will be made available each year for Turkey so as to co-finance the financial contribution to be paid by Turkey to participate in the programmes and agencies in the following year.

This fiche for the **2013 Financing Agreement** shows EU support for Turkey's participation, *inter alia*, in the programmes and agencies listed in the table below for the year **2014**.

(*) If there remaining IPA funds that may arise, for example because of the decision of not-participating to some of the Programmes, those funds could be allocated on the remaining of the Programmes based on the decisions of Ministry for EU Affairs of Turkey.

The contribution from the national budget covers the difference between the total financial contribution of Turkey to the programme as will be indicated in the International Agreements establishing the terms and conditions for participation in the Union Programme concerned, and the EU financial support.

4. Implementation Arrangements

4.1. The National Fund is responsible for the allowable Pre-accession financial assistance share of the financial contribution to be paid by the country to participate in Union Programmes and Agencies.

4.2 Upon signature of the Financing Agreement, the National Fund will request from the Commission the transfer of the full amount² of Pre-accession financial assistance indicated in section 3 above. These funds must be used to pay the EU share of the financial contribution to be paid by Turkey to participate in Union Programmes and Agencies.

Turkey shall pay its total financial contribution indicated in section 3 above in the column "total cost" as stipulated in the relevant International Agreement signed between Turkey and the European Commission.

4.3 The various Commission services responsible for the different programmes or agencies will send to the Permanent Delegation of Turkey to the EU a request for the total financial contribution for the participation in a given programme or agency ("call for funds"). The National Fund should check the amount to be financed from Pre-accession financial assistance funds and then transfer the amount as per the call for funds to the Commission service responsible. When making the payment for each programme, the National Fund should quote the reference number indicated in the call for funds for the programme concerned, and send simultaneously a copy of the payment order to the relevant Commission service.
