introduced an IT system with **EU** funding and expert advice from the EBRD. Now Nigyar has a bookshop chain of 5 stores and even two book cafes.

worked together with an experienced business adviser from the EBRD as part of EU support to help him **expand his business.** The turnover of Nikolay's company increased by 65% in one year.

received a loan to buy more space with a better location for his dental practice. Now, the number of clients has increased. Omar plans to add two dental chairs in his new surgery.

received **EU funding** and advice from EBRD experts to improve the marketing of his wines. Now Andrian exports his wine to more than eight countries.
