2. Objectives

2.1. Overall Objective(s):

The overall objective of this 1.490 MEUR project is to strengthen the institutions and administrative capacity for the full application of the acquis communautaire.

2.2. Project purpose:

To provide Institution Building assistance (twinning, twinning light, or other form of technical assistance) to meet the requirements related to specific urgent and unforeseen needs, especially identified in the course of the accession negotiation process. In particular this facility may help to:

- assist the adoption and implementation of acquis in particular areas where assistance is still necessary;
- strengthen the institutional and operational capacity of public administration bodies in view of the future role in the implementation of the EU acquis;
- develop human resources of public administration institutions relevant for the implementation of the EU acquis;
- prepare for investment support in regulatory infrastructure (needs analysis, technical specifications and tender documentation).

2.3. Accession Partnership and NPAA priority

The AP and NPAA priorities are to be strictly followed when preparing the specifications for the individual projects financed under this facility.

3. Description

3.1. Background and justification

As Lithuania enters the final stage of accession preparation, a clear need has arisen to have an institution building instrument which allows flexible and fast respond to address specific urgent and unforeseen needs, especially identified in the course of the accession negotiation process.

To address this need already last year the first unallocated institution building envelope was prepared under the Phare Lithuania 2001 programme – LT01.09.03 'Twinning Light' Reserve. The demand for using this reserve between various beneficiaries has been very high.

Under the proposed Phare 2002 programme 1.490 MEUR will be provided to the unallocated institution building envelope, which will cover not only Twinning Light, but also "normal" twinning and other forms of technical assistance on a more flexible basis than covered by the current twinning light arrangements and will address specific urgent high priority needs.

3.2. Linked activities

LT01.09.03 'Twinning Light' Reserve.

The activities under this project will follow up from previous Phare activities and will be coordinated with all ongoing projects.

3.3. Results

The project will assist ministries and governmental institutions in full adoption and enforcement of the *acquis*. Each project will have specific results indicated in the individual Terms of Reference.



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3.4. Activities

Funded projects will rest on a number of fundamental principles:

- Projects will be based on priorities identified in the Accession Partnership, the NPAA, Regular Report, Action Plan for Reinforcing Lithuania's Administrative and Judicial Capacity or emerge from the ongoing negotiation process. There will be cases where the relationship with the acquis will be concretely established, but there might also be cases, were a focused institution building project will be the most suitable method for the achievement of a desired result in a broader sense of the acquis or in fulfillment of the Copenhagen criteria.
- The project will target very specific areas where Institution Building support is required in relation to the challenges and requirements of the EU integration process and to the negotiation chapters: increasing the capacity to manage community assistance, including preparation for EDIS and future Structural Funds, preparation of relevant administrative structures for future accession.
- The project targets concrete guaranteed result.
- The beneficiary lays out a clear work programme, how it intends to achieve the result and what means it will deploy.
- Size and budget of projects will be subject of individual assessment.
- All projects should be in full compliance with the PHARE guidelines.
- Projects can be implemented in the form of twinning, twinning light and technical assistance.

Activities will be primarily related to the project implementation. Specific activities will be indicated in the Terms of Reference provided for each individual project. The Steering Committee for the Unallocated IB Envelope will be established to ensure proper and timely use of the allocated funds.

3.5. Lessons Learned

The experience gained from the implementation of the previous projects will be used and lessons learned will be incorporated into individual projects' design.

4. Institutional Framework

The beneficiaries of funds of the unspecified envelope will be different Lithuanian institutions implementing projects financed under this envelope. Decision on projects to be submitted for financing within the budget will be taken by the Steering Committee for the Unallocated Institution Building Envelope, which will include representatives from the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Lithuania (NAC), the EC Delegation to Lithuania and CFCU. The Steering Committee will be chaired by the representative of the Ministry of Finance and will be established within three months after the signature of the Financing Memorandum.
