## An Explanatory Note on the Indicator Charts

The annex presents more detailed information for each EU support to refugees in Türkiye Results Framework indicator, reported in Monitoring Report Number 13. The data fields include baselines, targets, recent indicator values, achievement rates, and changes since the previous report (Monitoring Report Number 12). The information is presented using dashboard graphics from the SUMAF data management system (DMS).

For the indicators with historical data, trends over time are presented in bar charts to help readers understand performance over time. Where data relates to specific provinces, a 'heat map' is provided where the colour density shows the relative indicator values. This visual analysis simplifies the understanding of geographical data and highlights the top ten provinces in terms of progress achieved. Further disaggregated data is provided for most of the indicators, for example, by gender, nationality, or age group, to provide a more granular understanding.

The 'change since last report' section presents any updates on new data or changes that have emerged since the last Monitoring Report (Monitoring Report 12, 30 June 2023).

### **Indicators with zero values**

As data collection for the underlying projects had not started at 30 June 2024, the MBM indicators are included with zero values.

The indicators which were dropped in the review of Version 3 of the Results Framework have been removed from the Annex. This has resulted in some gaps in the sequential numbering of the indicators.

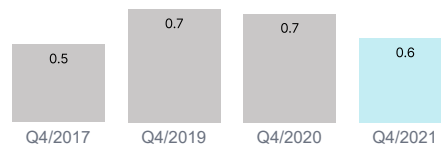

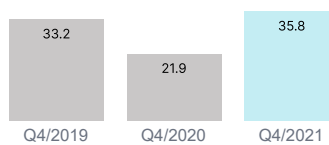

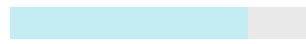

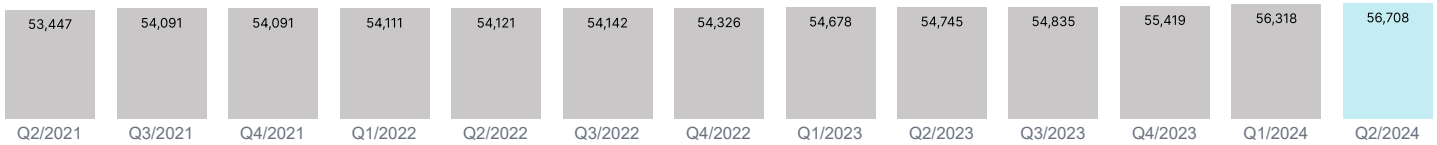

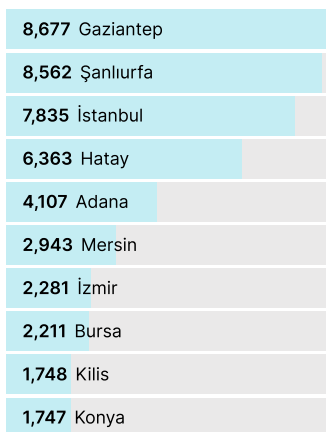

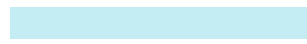

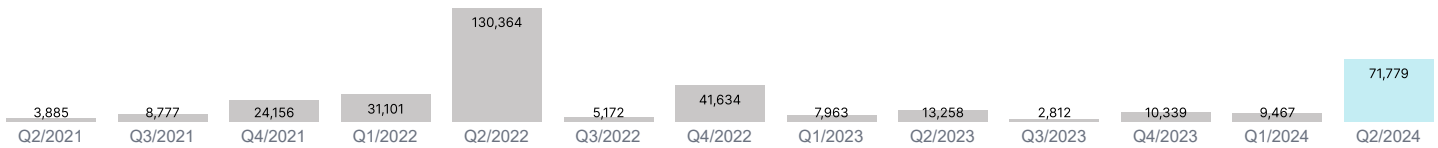

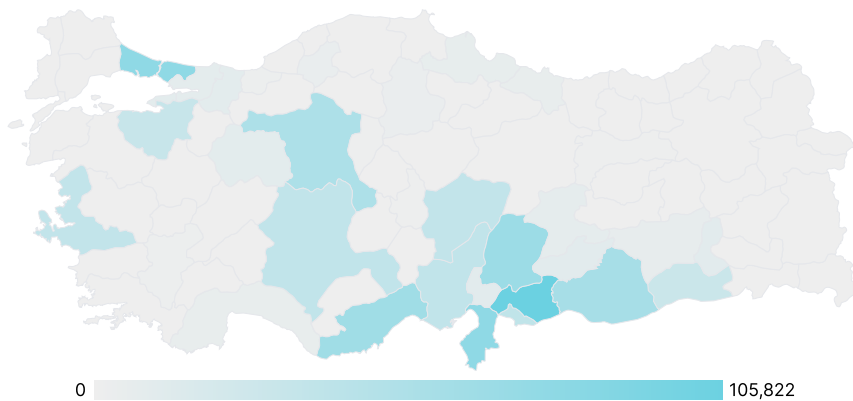
