THE FACILITY FOR REFUGEES IN TURKEY

The Facility is the answer to the EU Member States' call for significant additional funding to support refugees in the country. The Facility is implemented as humanitarian and development assistance, with the first tranche having been fully committed and contracted, with 72 projects rolled out and showing tangible results.



€2.4 billion HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

The Facility responds to the most urgent needs of refugees and host communities with:

- Monthly transfers to cover the basic needs through the Emergency Social Safety Net
- Support to education through the Conditional Cash Transfer for Education programme - Education in emergencies
- Access to healthcare services
- Protection of vulnerable groups, including women and children



€3.6 billion DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE

The Facility provides both refugees and host communities with support in:

- Education
- Health
- Municipal infrastructure
- Socio-economic support
